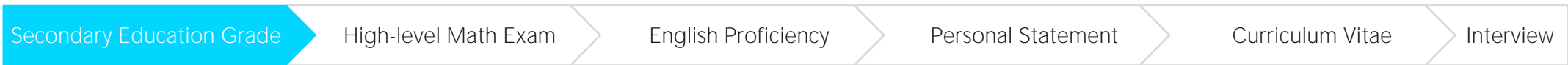

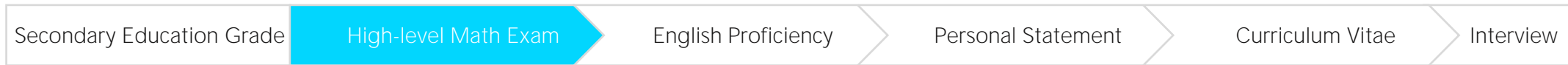


Secondary Education Grade

Applicants can apply with predicted grades, before completing their Secondary Education. The predicted grade for the Secondary Education **Average is the final grade of qualification an applicant's school believes they're likely to achieve in a positive outcome.** In this case, applicants have to present their Diploma Statement (download statement here), signed by a Secondary Education Teacher or Counselor, and submit their official Transcript of Records with all grades from the last two years and up to the point when the student submits the application.

Applicants must complete or prove they will complete Secondary Education by 31 August of the academic year. By that time they must present their final Diploma. Applicants who have already finished Secondary Education when they start their application must submit the Final Diploma and Certificate with grades.

High-level Math Exam

To apply to the International Undergraduate Program applicants must pass a High-level Mathematics Exam (minimum grade: 60%), either in the current academic year or in one of the two previous academic years. If the student applies prior to passing the Mathematics Exam, the predicted grade on the Mathematics Exam must also be included in the Diploma Statement.

If you have already passed the Mathematics Exam at the time you apply, you must submit your result.

IMPORTANT: the hard copy of the Certificate with the final grade/score of the Math Exam must be permanently submitted to the Admissions Office.

English Proficiency

To fulfill the English Proficiency requirement, an applicant can either:

- Have a **waiver** and thus fulfill the requirement automatically or;
- Provide an **English Certificate** (e.g. CAE, IELTS or TOEFL);
- Perform an **English Test** at CLSBE.

The recommended English level is C1 in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

WAIVER: Applicants are granted a waiver if they are native English speakers ; OR if they have been taught exclusively in English for at least one year during secondary education.

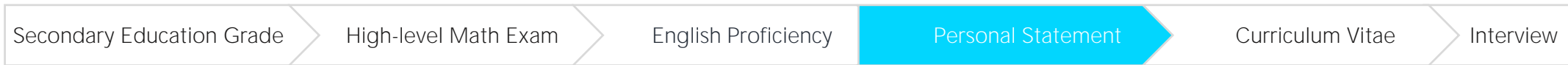
ENGLISH CERTIFICATE: The applicant must provide one of the following Certificates as proof of English Proficiency, before the start of the program.

CERTIFICATE	TOEFL	IELTS	CAE
RECOMMENDED SCORES	600 (PBT), 250 (CBT), or 100 (IBT) or higher	7.0, no subscore below 6.0	C or higher

The Digital English Certificate must be presented to the Admissions Office until July.

ENGLISH TEST: If you do not have any English Certificate, an Internal English Test may be performed exclusively on Campus throughout the application period. The Test will supply a score for the English level of the applicant.

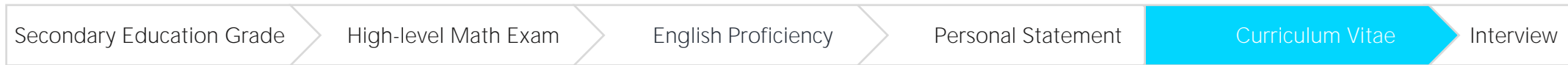
Personal Statement

The Personal Statement is the best way for the panel to learn more about you and know why you decided to apply to the Program. The Personal Statement (REQUEST template) should be 350 - 500 words.

To help you in writing your Personal Statement consider the following:

- Why do you want to study at CLSBE?
- What would you like to tell us about yourself that could be relevant, in order to motivate your application? For instance, do you have an International profile?
- What makes you a unique applicant?

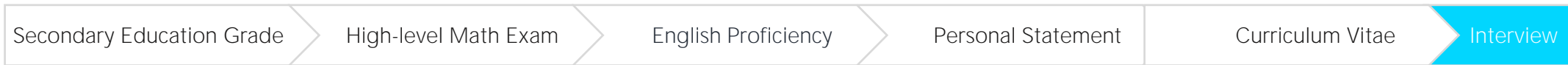

Curriculum Vitae

The Curriculum Vitae is very important for the admissions panel to know about any other activities the student has done. You should include any academic and professional experiences you may have, as well as volunteer work, sports, languages spoken, and any other relevant activities or events you have participated in.
